

Advent - a litany of good advice

Let's pile up all the Advent recommendations in the readings this weekend: 'Lord, you are our Father, we the clay...the work of your hands' "our Lord Jesus Christ will keep us steady and without blame until the last day" 'Be on your guard, stay awake'. Three times in the gospel we are told - STAY AWAKE! Remember though that this wakefulness (woke?) is not driven by a kind of nervous fear. It is a constant readiness to welcome the Master. This is the real meaning of Advent; we are preparing to greet the coming of Jesus. Yes, in Bethlehem but more importantly in the here and now moments of our lives; in the sadness and setbacks of the virus, in the hope and promise of vaccines. 'Watch out' might be the special words of our Advent admonition. We watch for the day to inherit the promise! Ultimately Advent invites us to wait in hope for the final coming of our Lord Jesus

Open for Mass - Thanks be to God

Providing there are no setbacks, the church should be open on this coming Friday for 7pm Mass! A joy! We then return to our normal COVID schedule. In this newsletter, there is a reminder of the COVID guidelines for places of worship. This time of opening is a real gift for our Advent journey.



There will be two Masses on Christmas Eve: 5.30pm and Midnight. There will be challenges! Our numbers are limited under COVID guideline - 48! No singing! No Christmas carols! Shorter Masses. On Christmas Day -Masses will be at 8am and 10am - with the same restrictions. ALL Masses will require tickets - which will be available from next weekend. Please note that the tickets will be for specific Masses. Subject to the demand for tickets, a third Mass may be arranged on Christmas Day at 11.15am.

All things being equal - Father Michael will celebrate the Sacrament of the Holy Spirit next Sunday 6 December at 12noon. Our candidates (Emilia Acuti, Isabella Borgese, Emer Fadian, Josh Ioannou, Olivia Ioannou,

Chiemezue Nwamba, Caitlyn Pereira, Cameron Tabarrok, Amelia Willoughby) will be marked with Oil of Chrism blessed by the Cardinal in the Cathedral. 9 candidates will mean 6 guests each under COVID restrictions. Importantly there will be a final meeting of the candidates in the church on <u>Thursday 3</u> <u>December at 5pm - including a short rehearsal for the ceremony.</u> Please pray for our young parishioners on such a special day.

<u>Church Safety Arrangements – A Reminder</u>
