Project Update - Tony Murphy

Welcome back into the Church. There still remains work to be done and the Contractor returns in the New Year to complete the final elements including the reinstatement of the Baldacchino, Pulpit and Altar Rails. It has been important to the Project Team that the Church was available for Christmas services, albeit without use of the Choir Loft and Our Lady's Side Altar. It has been a difficult year with these works undertaken in the midst of a pandemic, and I thank you for your patience and understanding on such, and sincerely hope that the Church return will aid in your celebration of this joyful occasion and celebration of Our Lord's Birth.

In returning to the Church, the following Covid arrangements apply:
